## **EQUIPMENT OPERATOR**

The Equipment Operator works under the direction of the Streets Division Supervisor; operates various equipment to clean, repair, and maintain City streets, sidewalks, curbs, gutters, and signs.

#### POSITION SUMMARY

Under the direction of the Streets Division Manager, the Equipment Operator operates various types of equipment for the maintenance of City streets and sidewalks.

#### **ESSENTIAL RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES**

- 1. Operates a variety of equipment in performing street maintenance tasks
  - 1.1 Patches and repairs pot holes
  - 1.2 Assist with laying of asphalt and smoothing asphalt patches
  - 1.3 Repairs and replaces City street signs
  - 1.4 Cleans and repairs storm drains, and gutters
  - 1.5 Paints crosswalks, stop bars and legends
  - 1.6 Operates snow removal equipment
  - 1.7 Operates street sweeper

## MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

## **EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE AND CERTIFICATIONS**

- Graduation from high school or GED equivalent and two years related experience, or any equivalent combination of related education and experience.
- Must possess a valid state driver's license with CDL endorsement (including Tanker endorsements) or have the ability to obtain one prior to employment.
